Introduction: Summary from last week (John 1:14,16,17; Jer.31:3,4))

Key Terms/Definitions:

The free gift - Charisma – a gift of grace, a free gift, an undeserved favor, grace endowments

Grace – Charis (grace, as a gift or blessing brought to man by Jesus Christ, favor, gratitude, thanks, kindness)

Give Thanks – Eucharists (eucharistos) – gratitude, actively, grateful language (to God, as an act of worship), thankfulness. Luke 22, During the institution of the Eucharist Jesus “gave thanks”

For the **life** of the flesh is **in the blood**, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.' Leviticus 17:11
