



Minister Hunn Non-Traditional Student Scholarship

The Minister Hunn Non-Traditional Student Scholarship is a one-time nonrenewable scholarship distributed over the fall and spring semesters. This scholarship is for non-traditional students (students pursuing a vocational degree, or students attending a community college).

Requirements for Consideration:

Church Membership — All applicants should be members of Consolidated Baptist Church and be faithful in worship attendance, Sunday School, and Bible Study. Applicants must also have served in at least one ministry in the church.

Application Form — Each section of the application form must be completed and typed.

Letter of Acceptance to College/Vocational school — The letter of application should include a copy of your college/vocational acceptance letter or an acknowledgement of receipt of your application for acceptance at your intended school.

Unofficial Transcript — An unofficial high school transcript should accompany your application form.

Interview— Applicants must interview with the scholarship committee at a time agreeable to all.
